
Live births and deaths since 1951

Mortality 2020 by selected causes of death


Deaths per 100,000 inhabitants of one sex

Childcare and schoolchildren since 2011/12




Unemployed people and jobs registered since 1997*

Structure of agricultural holdings 1999, 2010* and 2021* by size classes of agricultural area used (AAU)



in millions of animals





Share in total imports: 51.8%




Export by countries of destination

Share in total imports: 51.5%




Guests arrivals and overnight stays in tourist accommodation and campsites* 2021 by country of origin of guests

in percent




Overnight stays of guests from abroad by country of origin








Number of nursing homes


